Lisa used writing songs, and poems to cope with the trauma of being physically and sexually abused as a child and experiencing domestic violence as an adult.

After performing in many R&B and gospel groups, Lisa decided to follow her passion and step out as a solo artist. Releasing her first singles in 2014 entitle, "Shine," and "Not Like You."

Currently residing in Houston, Texas, Lisa Denae has worn many hats during her professional career. Driven by her pain and passion, Lisa Denae founded Cultivate Courage, Inc. a non-profit organization that advocates for survivors of child abuse, sexual assault, and domestic violence.

In 2019, Lisa Denae released a powerful relationship anthem, "Love Myself More," to honor friends she is lost to domestic violence and celebrate her personal transformation through self-love and forgiveness. A portion of the proceeds from all Lisa Denae's music and shows are donated to Cultivate Courage Inc., and other non-profit organizations who advocate for survivors of child abuse, sexual assault, and domestic violence.

In 2020, Lisa unfortunately lost another close friend to domestic violence. After years of advocating, public speaking and facilitating workshops, Lisa searched for another way to let her voice be heard and provide a platform for others to have a voice as well. To that end. Stunner Radio was born.
